

Card Management Software (CMS)

General Description

Designed for use with the PeopleAccess Single Door System, the CMS Software manages card issuing and the setting of access credentials for system users. The CMS can administer multiple doors equipped with the PeopleAccess system and - unlike competitive software - is simple and efficient to use.

CMS functionality includes enrolment of users, establishing the grant access list, the temporary deny access list, and the permanent hot list. The CMS also supports auditing of Door Readers.

Interfacing with a BridgePoint Desk Top PC Reader, the CMS can write access data to User Cards including the Start Date, Expiration Date and the appropriate "Grant" or "Deny" status for 8 different access tables. By securely programming access data on the User Card there is no need to go to every door to program individual access systems whenever a new User is added.

Management Cards can be used to transport a Hot List, Deny Access Lists, Strike Activities Log and the status of Reader Restrictions, eliminating the need for expensive handheld devices.

Once data is imported to the CMS, reports can be viewed by Door Reader, User Card ID number, and event date and time. The Software can also display the access privileges for every User Card.

The CMS also includes a Card Maintenance drop-down menu that can be used to initialize Management Cards for reuse in the system.
